## Vintage Notes:

Yet another wet start to the season, but July and August compensated for it. 2013 turned out to be the hottest summer of the decade, followed by one of the coolest falls we have ever seen. It was a great year for grape growing, giving us fine tannins as well as balanced and concentrated flavours.

This Pinot Noir was hand picked from our own 19-year-old vines as well as our neighbour's, Four Shadows Vineyard, on the 9<sup>th</sup> of October and 22<sup>nd</sup> of October 2013 at 2.64 tons per acre.
